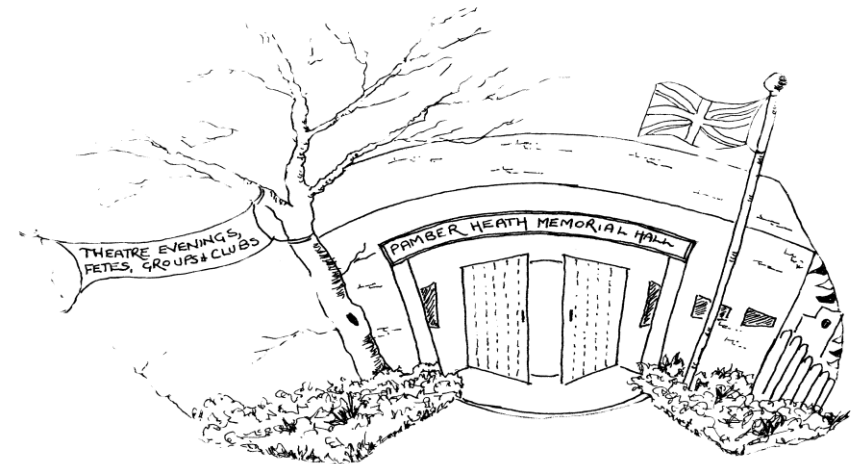

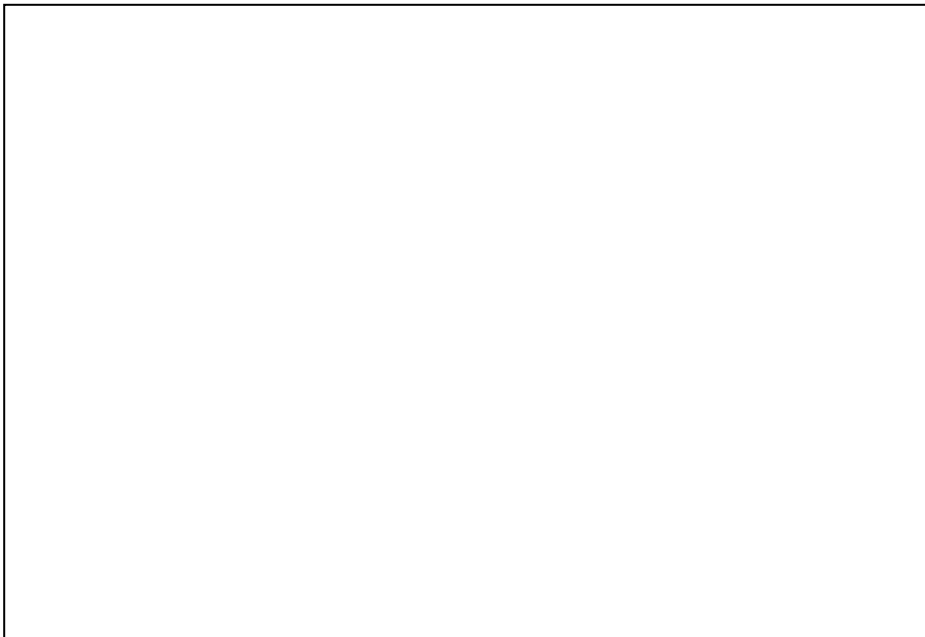
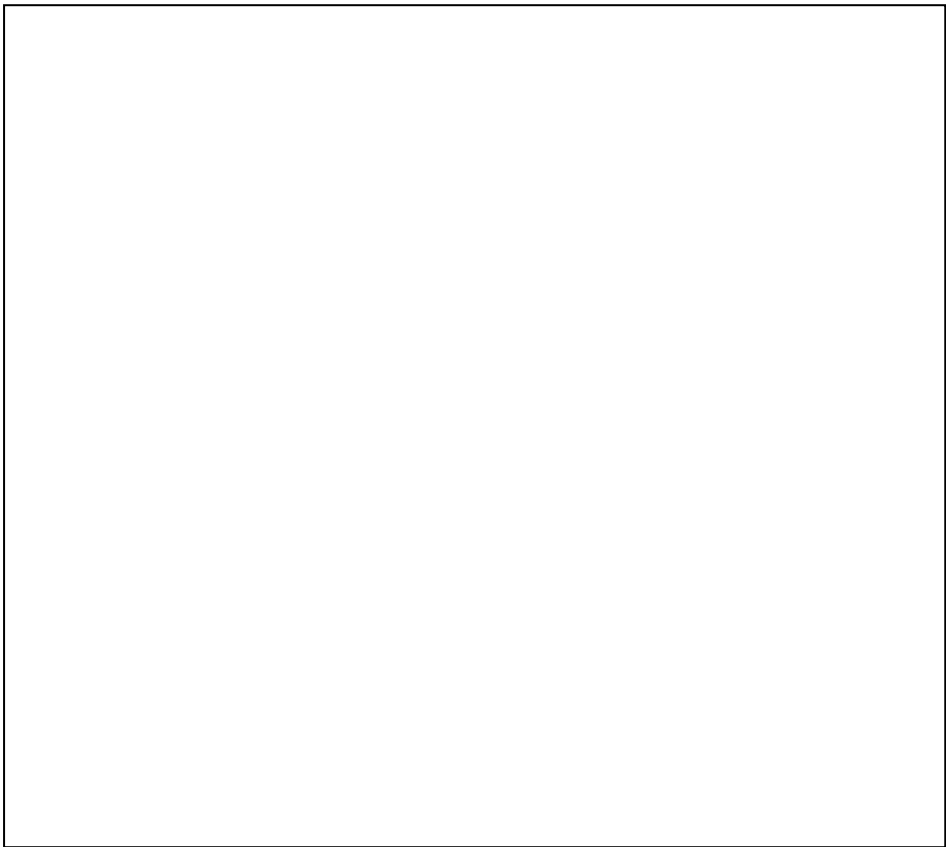
Jumble Sale

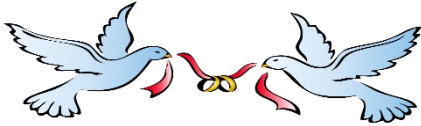
