Outdoor cinema


Gates open 7.30pm, last entry 8.45pm. The film will begin when the sun has set at around 9pm finishing 11.30pm.

New Build

Well, at last we have the news we've been waiting for. Planning permission has been granted for our long-awaited extension and revamp! We amended the plans before they were finally sent into the council's planning department, taking in to account comments made by some of our neighbours.

So, what difference will it make to the hall?

The only difference to the large hall will be the re-siting of the chair and table store and bowls cupboard. This will allow for a small stage to be where the existing store is now. As you know, we rely on fundraising for the maintenance and upkeep of the hall. For theatre and entertainment evenings a stage will be invaluable for the acts and bands to perform on and free up more floor space for dancing!

The back hall will be made slightly larger making it more suitable for smaller parties who will not have to feel so 'insignificant' in a large hall and allow for two lettings at the same time.

One of the areas that really does need addressing is the toilets. The new build will re-site all toilet areas allowing for more cubicles in the ladies and better disabled toilet facilities.

Don't worry Gents, your toilets will be revamped too!

Speaking of toilets, we will also be adding some toilets to the rear of the hall which can be accessed by those using the grounds.

An extension will be built at the front of the building which will house the preschool allowing it to open from 9.15 to 2.45 every day and for them to have their equipment out all the time. At present everything needs to come out and be put back for each session, which is very labour intensive!

Once the new build is underway, we will turn our attention to the outside area, mainly the tennis court areas and the possibility of a children's play area.

Of course, we don't have the money to pay for it yet! That relies on grants and funding. There are many meetings to be held and a lot of hard work filling in all the forms and writing begging letters.
